TRANSPORTATION:

For attendees traveling by air and arriving at the Corpus Christi International Airport (CCIA) on May 16th: The airport is about 50 minutes from the House Schoenstatt Retreat Center Lamar (HSRC-L) in Rockport, Texas.

Researching economical group transportation possibilities resulted in the following: If you provide your flight information by May 3rd (see Registration Form), we will be able to arrange for transport (up to 6 persons for \$75.00 one way [not including tip]) with the American Cab Service; they have Crown Victoria autos or vans. Payment will be made directly at time of taxi use; your share will depend on the number of persons in your group. We will email you the names and flight information of your group members and any other needed instructions.

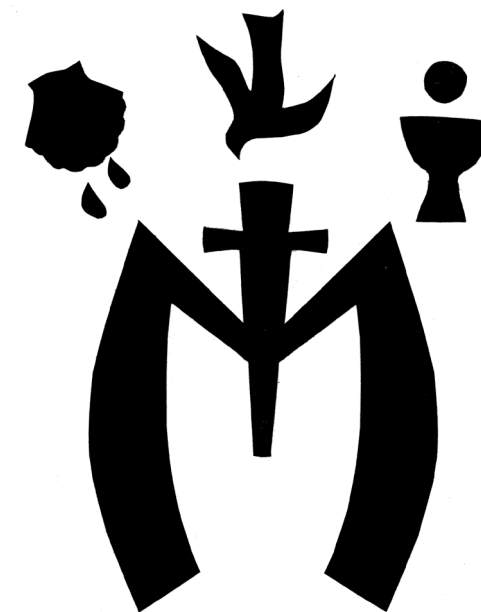
