**For those traveling by air:**

Arrive at the Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport.  
The meeting site is about 20 minutes away. The  
Franciscan Renewal Center has a special fare arranged  
with **SuperShuttle Shared Ride Van Service**. Curb  
representatives are present at all times outside the baggage  
claim area at each terminal. Look for the sign “Shared  
Ride/VAN SERVICE” and advise the representative that  
you would like transportation to the **Franciscan Renewal  
Center-Special Fare** of \$16.00 per person per direction.  
You will be told the van number assigned to take you there.  
Payment is in cash or credit cards in the vehicle.
